SPECIFIC:

A gift of a specific amount or item/asset from the estate to Casa de los Niños Foundation.

If you'd like to give a specific bequest to Casa de los Niños Foundation, you could use language like this:

"I'd like to give to Casa de los Niños Foundation, a charitable organization (Tax ID 86-0609655) located at 1120 N. 5th Avenue, Tucson, AZ, the sum of \$_____ for its general purposes."

RESIDUAL:

A residual gift is made from the residue of the estate after all other wishes are fulfilled, or a percentage of the estate.

If you'd like to add Casa de los Niños Foundation as a beneficiary of the residue of an estate, you could use language like this:

"All the rest, residue, and remainder of my estate I give to Casa de los Niños Foundation, a charitable organization (Tax ID 86-0609655) located at 1120 N. 5th Avenue, Tucson, AZ 85705, for its general purposes."

CONTINGENT:

A contingent gift can be used only if the designated beneficiaries (usually children or family members) are unable to accept the estate gift.

If you'd like to add Casa de los Niños Foundation as a contingent beneficiary, you could use language like this:

"If my primary beneficiary/ies (name of beneficiary/ies) does/do not survive me, then I give [the sum of \$X / a percentage of my estate / a specific asset] to Casa de los Niños Foundation, a charitable organization (Tax ID 86-0609655) located at 1120 N. 5th Avenue Tucson, AZ 85705, for its general purposes."
